GCSE Results Day Arrangements: Thursday 24th August

Results Day is an opportunity to celebrate each student's achievements and we are excited to share in the students' successes. We are also conscious that the day can also cause anxieties for some. We want to support every student as best we can, both in celebrating their results and any individual support they may need.

We ask that you read the following information carefully.

Results will be issued in the Chapel from 8.30am. To minimise the number of people in the building, we are asking that parents do not come into the school unless you are picking up your son/daughter's results.

Students should enter via the Chapel gate and make their way to the Chapel entrance.

Inside the Chapel, staff will be on hand to issue the students with their results. Once students have collected their results, they can leave the Chapel UNLESS they fall into one of four groups (Staff will be available in the venues to guide students.)

1. Students who have met the sixth form entry requirements but who have not met the subject requirements of one or more of their A level subject choices.
2. Students who have met the sixth form entry requirements and their A level subject choice requirements but who wish to change one of their A level choices.
3. Students who are leaving Blue Coat School to pursue their education elsewhere.
4. Students who have not met the sixth form entry requirements.

Students in group 1 and 2 will be directed to the Sixth Form Study Library for a meeting with Mr Shipgood discuss option choices.

Students in group 3 and 4 will be directed to the Sixth Form common room to receive advice and guidance regarding their next steps.
