#### **3 A Levels Entrance Criteria**

- GCSE Mathematics grade 6 or above
- GCSE English grade 6 or above
- 52 points from your best 8
   GCSE's
- Subject specific criteria

#### **4 A Levels Entrance Criteria**

- GCSE Mathematics grade 6 or above
- GCSE English grade 6 or above
- 62 points from your best 8 GCSE's
- Subject specific criteria
- Further Maths can only be chosen as a 4<sup>th</sup> subject – (Choice must also include Maths)




## **Options Process**
