Subject	Work Set
Art	<p>Students should have been submitting work via Teams as set and maintaining steady progress on their portfolio. Some resolved pieces out of the sketchbook should be emerging with strong supportive studies in the sketchbook also. The general rule of 2 sketchbook pages every week and 1 'finished piece' every 2 weeks is a good rule of thumb to keep up with the expected level of progress.</p> <p>The extended written task draft should have been submitted already and feedback and advice provided. This should be edited and developed over the Summer so a final draft can be submitted by October Half Term. Supporting reading and research should be done over the Summer to develop the contextual references for your ideas.</p>
Biology	<p>Students need to complete the work emailed over by classroom teachers. They should continue to consolidate their revision and use the online videos and question packs available on the VLE as appropriate. The research and poster task is available for those up to date with the work. Biology clinic is running at 12.30pm on Wednesday 15th July via Microsoft teams.</p>
Chemistry	<p>Students will complete the work on infra red spectroscopy and Mass Spectrometry using the video lessons and worksheets provided. Live clinic sessions will be available for any students wishing to ask questions. Past AS Level papers will be set as consolidation work for the summer.</p>
CIAG	<p>All students should have registered on UCAS and should have completed the personal details and education section. Students should continue working with staff on their Personal Statements. Early applicant students should be preparing for their entry tests and should ensure that they book in the relevant tests. All students should plan to attend online University/apprenticeship/career open days and continue to look at their plans after Blue Coat. A checklist will be sent out via email of the work set and what should have been completed during lockdown. Students should be ready to show their CIAG teacher this work in September.</p>

Economics	Complete all of the Tutor2u online lessons that have been sent out via email. Complete all of the multiple choice questions that have been sent out via email ensuring that all answers are reviewed thoroughly. Attend the online lesson Monday at 11am and drop in session Tuesday at 4pm if necessary. Study past papers in preparation for an assessment of all Y12 material at the start of Sept.
English	English Literature students should continue with tasks posted by Mrs Bennett and Miss Smith. The Language and Literature group should have sent Mr Kershaw details of the texts they are studying and their area of study for the NEA. Language and Literature students are strongly advised to attend the final Teams meeting of the Year on Wednesday 15th July at 11am when scene 10 of "Streetcar" will be discussed.
EPQ	Students should follow guidance given out during school on 15/16/17th July. If students cannot attend this guidance will be sent out to them. A checklist will be sent out via email of the work set and what should have been completed during lockdown. Students should be ready to show their EPQ teacher this work in September.
French	Mrs Ward- Complete assessment, Miss Albinana- Speaking sessions and work on La Haine, Miss Rowe- section of grammar booklet.
Geography	Mr Frost - Students are required to work through the "Changing Places" unit. The final weekly email will be sent with specific guidance. Miss Nock - students are required to work on "Hazards" detailed guidance is sent out weekly via email.
History	A final set of tasks will be sent out in relation to the French History NEA and all their coursework portfolios should be updated and submitted before the end of the Summer. In Tudor History students will complete their work on Foreign Policy and will begin looking at society & culture by 1547. There will also be a quiz in the last online lesson of term.
Latin	Students should complete the Latin Remote Learning Checklist to ensure they have done all the compulsory work set during lockdown, and complete any tasks arising from the session held in school this week.

Maths	Maths students are using Dr Frost Maths and the VLE to study Logs and Exponentials, and Trigonometry (Kerboodle Ch5 and Ch14) with FM students studying Proof, Complex Numbers, Matrices and Vectors (Active Learn Core Pure 1 Ch 1,2,6,7,8,9 and Core Pure 2 Ch 1). Assessments in Dr Frost will be live from Monday 6 July and should be completed by Friday 17 July.
Music	Ensure all work for Miss Horton and Mr Emery is complete and assessments sent in. All compositions should have been submitted by now. If not submitted, please do so as soon as possible. Check all other work is complete via the lockdown master document. Continue daily routine of instrumental practice.
Physics	An email is sent out each working day to all Y12 physics students drawing their attention to specific issues with the topic for the day and to supplementary resources which will help them in completion of the revision tasks provided.
Politics	Mr Pearson's Supreme Court essays are due for the final week of term and he has emailed out a set of links and Podcasts for students to read/listen to over the Summer. In British Politics students are expected to complete their booklets on Political Parties, read the two articles that have been sent to them and complete the practice question.
Psychology	Students should consolidate on their face to face teaching and Teams lessons to complete the lockdown topics confidence diagnostic due before the end of term. Students should also be able to use this week to explore their new online learning platform. Literature on origins of psychology should be read through including the exam question and model answer.
Spanish	Mr Adamson - Students should read through the PowerPoints sent by e-mail about 20th Century Spain and continue to work on their IRP (due 25th September). Miss Sánchez - work on the materials sent by e-mail about Gabriel Garcia Márquez. Mr O'Brien - prepare speaking materials and attend sessions on Teams.
