Subject	Work Set
Art	<p>Students should have completed the weekly workshop tasks that have been set on Teams and are submitted on there also. Completion of these tasks will set students up for a successful and confident return in September, so please review the various tasks, and if required, complete any outstanding over the summer.</p> <p>We will begin a new Coursework project upon our return in September, most likely portraits based, but will be reviewing the work completed over lockdown, so please do ensure that all work is up to date and that skills, particularly observational drawing, have been kept up to date.</p>
Biology	<p>Students need to complete up to lesson 27 on the VLE. Instructions are found in the folder KS4-work for school closure and mark schemes will be emailed over on Friday afternoon.</p>
Business	<p>Continue working on the key knowledge sheets that are sent out via email. Use Tutor2u, your classwork booklets or the online textbook to help you. Students should also ensure that they have completed all tasks on the spreadsheet to be submitted in September.</p>
Chemistry	<p>Answers to recent questions will be posted onto the VLE for students to check their answers. They should evaluate any key gaps in understanding and evaluate any key areas to work on next year. There will also be a set of summary questions on Organic Chemistry for students to complete</p>
Computer Science	<p>Students to consolidate their programming skills by creating a virtual pet in Python. Students can implement additional features such as saving the pet's data to an external text file. Students should consider using functions to ensure their programme is efficient. Students should screenshot and submit their work via Teams.</p>
DT	<p>Complete all chapter work for 5 and 6 using the 'Dynamic Learning' platform and the notes located in TEAMS for KS4 DT.</p>

English	All students should continue with the activities on the GCSE war poetry anthology as posted on the VLE or sent via email. Mr. Kershaw and Mrs. Ludlow's group should complete the assignment posted on Teams.
French	Complete the activities on VLE and use solutions to help.
Geography	Year 9 Geographers should ensure that they have finished their Living World workbook up to lesson 24 and have filled in the personal learning checklist at the end of the workbook ready for September. Students will have an end of unit exam on Living World in September and so they should revise in preparation for this. 9F should ensure that they have finished the Rivers workbook for Mr Jones and Living World workbook for Mr Frost.
History	Students will not be set any new learning in the final week of term, but they should use their time to ensure that the weekly tasks that Miss Lowsley has set them via email on the Conflict & Tension module are completed by the time we reconvene in September. All the work should be copied straight into their exercise books, or it should be typed, printed and brought into school for our first lesson back.
