

Summary of Remote Learning Provision

Remote Lessons

During this period of remote learning, students are expected to follow the school timetable including attending their key stage assemblies. The timetable can be seen here:

Remote live lessons are taking place using Microsoft Teams in all subject areas including Personal development for all Key Stages and CIAG and EPQ for Key Stage 5. Staff are delivering lessons in engaging ways on Teams, including PowerPoint presentations, Q&A sessions, Use of Breakout Rooms and Whole class debates. We are constantly striving to be as innovative and engaging as possible whilst working remotely. Core PE are recorded for students to access. In addition, the PE department are putting activities on Teams for students to participate in on a regular basis.

Assessment

During the period of remote learning, assessment is continuing to take place, with staff primarily setting work using the assignment function on Teams. The assignment function allows staff to set work and for students to submit it with relative ease. It also enables staff to provide high quality and effective marking and feedback so that students can still make good progress whilst working from home.

Homework

Any homework will continue to be set using our Edulink communication platform. This is to ensure that students can stay as organised as possible with their workload throughout the remote learning period.

Devices

School is committed to supporting students in their access of remote learning and provided a good number of students with devices to use at home to access lessons and class materials.

Pastoral Provision/ SEND additional needs

Teachers are being guided on how best to support the learning of our students with additional needs.

Students are expected to attend form time remotely which is currently on a Monday morning from 8:40-9:10am. Meeting with their form tutor on a weekly basis gives the form tutor the opportunity to check on how each pupil is coping with remote learning and provide any necessary support to the students.

The Student Support department is working alongside form tutors and Key Stage Leaders to support individual students throughout the week via email and meetings on Teams in order

to support students' pastoral needs beyond form time. Students regularly not attending lessons are contacted to offer any support that may be needed.
